#### NEW STATEWIDE ALL-MEMBERS EMAIL GROUP

Beginning this fall, we will have a statewide all-members email group. This will enable any member to send a message to ALL members with email, all at once. The primary function of the email group will be to allow the leadership team to make announcements quickly and easily. But it's something

that all members will be able to use.

For now, the group will include all teaching members of senior clubs. Adult and junior students will not be included. So if you are a teaching member of a senior club, and you have email, you should be seeing a message in a few weeks in your inbox with more details.

Please note:

- We will be using Google Groups -- a proven system with a track record of virtually no spam or technical issues.

- Some clubs are already doing this very successfully at the local level. It hasn't caused an increase in the amount of emails they get from each other; rather, it has simply ensured that folks don't miss important messages.

- Group members will have the ability to opt out of receiving emails, and to request that messages be sent to a different address, or an additional one.

- Ideally the email group would only be used for the business of our organization, and if folks begin using the group for other purposes (such as gig or recital announcements, venting about the organi-zation, inappropriate messages, etc.) not only will they be shut down by the moderators of the group, but sometimes Google intervenes and flags messages before everyone gets them.


