MFMC Executive Committee Actions

The MFMC Executive Committee, Scholarships and Grants Committee Chair met on

Saturday, April 9, 2016

MFMC 2016 - 2017 Budget: This includes an increase in dues for Senior and Junior members and a Festival Cup fee increase. The dues/fee increase will be ratified at the MFMC July meeting. Our national organization, National Federation of Music Clubs, has raised Senior and Junior dues, cost for insurance coverage and a 20% increase in cost for festival cups. MFMC is experiencing declining Senior and Junior membership, and also wants to also maintain its support of scholarships and awards we offer students and members. Distributing awards and scholarships is an expected aspect of functioning as a non-profit organization.

Scholarships and Awards: \$1,600 for students to attend the Junior Composers Institute in Minneapolis in July, 2016.

Awarded up to \$800 for students applying to attend International Music Camp Scholarship.

Promote MFMC: find ways to promote MFMC for more participation in membership and participation in the festivals.

MFMC Membership Roster gets a "Re-Do"

The MFMC membership roster is protected and available only to members of MFMC with use of a user name and password on the MFMC web site. (*Remember to refresh this page on your computer*). MFMC wants the membership roster to be more accurate and user friendly. Every fall, each club will be asked to provide the following to the MFMC treasurer when paying dues:

- Members' <u>current</u> contact information.
- What does each member teach? Piano, Voice, etc.
- Which members are willing to judge?
- Identify your Club President(s) and Festival Site Manager(s)

Also noted at the top of the web site page is a list of all the clubs and their locations. With all this information you as a member can:

- Locate another MFMC teacher in the state. <u>This can also be helpful if one of your</u> <u>students is moving to a different town and wants to study with a MFMC teacher.</u>
- Locate members who may be willing to judge at your festivals and what they teach.
- Get information from a specific club, as you will know who the club president and festival site manager are to contact.

These new changes will only be helpful to the entire membership if each MFMC member provides the information requested. This should be processed by your club treasurer when collecting yearly dues every fall. All members, via direct email or club president, will receive the user name and password to view the membership roster (not to be shared outside our membership!!) and tips on how to use the membership roster!

FESTIVAL NEWS

Festival Chair Nadine Berg reports: The auditors are doing a great job and she is awaiting final reports to arrive so she can compile her final state report. The Hibbing Club was a test site for using the NFMC on-line festival registration. She reported several concerns and difficulties that were experienced and has forwarded this information to the national chairman.

From Festival Cup Chair Sarah Twedt: I would like to thank all record keepers for their hard work preparing their reports this past festival season! This is very detailed work and members should take time to thank these folks in your clubs for their dedication! All of the cups and plates have been ordered!

MFMC was informed in March, 2016 that Crown Trophy Co. had increased the cup prices by 20%. This added an additional cost of \$2,724.42 to our budget for cups which MFMC needed to absorb.

Now is the time to prepare for next year! If you have any questions or need help with any aspect of your reporting, please let me know. We would love to help you make the reporting process easier for you. We processed 4478 Cup Entrants and ordered 957 total cups! Of these, 2 were Grand Cup and 4 were President Cup Winners!

Junior Composers Summer Programs has become an associate member of MFMC.


