MFMC President's Message – Nancy's Notes

In August of 2017, there was a great deal of excitement about a solar event that occurs about every 100 years – a total eclipse of the sun. Our family waited with anticipation as August 21st approached. We met at the outdoor patio of a Warroad restaurant to view the first total eclipse in the United States since 1918, but unfortunately, the sky was cloudy, and we never did get a glimpse of the sun during the entire 90-minute window. My oldest son's family did more planning, expended more effort, and had a much better outcome. They drove from their home in Sioux Falls, SD to Lincoln, NE, which was reported to be the best location to view the event. When the clouds began to move in over Lincoln about an hour before the eclipse, Jay and his family started driving to find the sun. Driving west, the skies cleared after about 40 miles, and they found a and they found a camparound, parked next to a car with

a Hawaii license plate, and joined a crowd of people on a hillside. They had a spectacular view of the entire total eclipse of the sun!


Our National Guests from the National Federation of Music Clubs are Ouida and George Keck. We are pleased to have them join our 100th Anniversary Celebration!


