  - Each event can only be used once toward the total consecutive superiors when solo and concerto events are combined toward the same cup. Example: Jane has 7 consecutive superiors in the solo event. Now she is going to enter solo and concerto and combine points toward her solo cup. She gets a superior in both events. She now has 8 consecutive superiors in the solo event and only 1 consecutive superior in the concerto event. (The first 7 consecutive superiors were each used once in the solo event. They cannot be used again to achieve a higher number of consecutive superiors in concerto.)

**Anderson, Andrea:** This student has entered the LFO Piano Solo Event but is adding points towards a cup in Piano Solo. (The student is alternating between LFO Piano Solo and Piano Solo) much like students alternating between duet and trio events. Consecutive Superiors are continuous between these 2 events. **Please list this LFO event in your events list on the J3-3.** 

**Dover, David:** Student is playing a Piano Solo and Piano Concerto and combining these points to increase points in Piano Solo. He is following the rules for combining – 9<sup>th</sup> grade or higher, Difficult 1 Solo Level or higher. Total points for Piano Concerto are zero – points earned in 2023 are 8 and are added into the piano solo, total point's column. (Refer to Cup Report) Consecutive Superior counts continue for both separate events.

**Young, Barbara:** This student last participated in the festival in 2021 and transferred from a different club. The club from which she came is listed, as is the teacher name. She has only one consecutive superior as she skipped 1 year.

**Robinson, Jennifer:** Student is combining Vocal Solo-Art Song and Vocal Solo-Musical Theater points in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade! Students in grades 9-12 can combine points in musical theater and art song solo events. The solo class level must be Senior 1 or above and the art song choice piece must be sung in a foreign language.

**Carter, Caleb:** Student is alternating between Violin Concerto and Violin Solo events but is working towards a cup in Violin Solo. In this case, he is not working on a Violin Concerto for Concerto points, but rather is using the concerto repertoire in lieu of violin solo repertoire. **The event is Violin Solo**. Consecutive Superiors are continuous in the Violin Solo Event.
